PARKING COMMITTEE MINUTES

June 3, 1010

Meeting was called to order at 9:45 AM by GT Schramm.

- I. The minutes of the April 2010 meeting were approved as presented
- II. It was reported that the new residential stickers would begin to be available in July. They will be larger for better visibility. The employee and guest passes will also be a different design. The misuse of employee passes was discussed. Violations will result in the loss of the pass.
- III. The portion of the block of German Street from the Eros residence to the corner will be made residential only instead of 90 minute when the parking meters are installed in the lower part of the block.
- IV. The discussion of becoming proactive in finding additional parking in Town continued. Several possibilities were discussed. At least one will be worked on by Public Works for presentation to the owner.
- V. After discussion about the proposed Parking Garage, the Committee recommended that the Mayor write a letter to the President of Shepherd University with copies to appropriate others being clear that should it be necessary to make a choice among projects that providing appropriate parking for the students be Shepherd's chief priority.
- VI. Jefferson Security Bank will be approached about posting signs about parking being available in their lots after noon on Saturday and Sunday.
