PARKING COMMITTEE MINUTES

April 22, 2010

Trinity House--9:45 AM

Meeting was called to order at 9:45 AM by GT Schramm.

- I. The minutes of the March 2010 meeting were approved as presented
- II. It was reported that there had been parking issues on Ray Street. The recommendation of the Mayor and Chief Johnson was that one side of Ray Street be "No Parking" to allow for emergency vehicle access. This was referred to Public Works for action after consultation with Ray Street residents.
- III. It was reported that the speed limit on North Princess and North King Streets between German and High Streets would be changes to 15 MPH.
- IV. It was determined that the renewal of Parking Permits went well last year and the system used would be repeated this year. All Parking Permits expire on June 30. The month of July will be the time of renewal. Enforcement will resume August 1. The 90 minute parking signs will be removed from those areas as soon as Shepherd University graduation is over.
- V. A discussion of becoming proactive in finding additional parking in Town was had. Several possibilities were discussed. This is particularly important since it appears that it will be at least two years before the new Parking Garage can begin to be constructed. Mayor Auxer will pursue one of them. It is anticipated that meters will be placed in the parking area in front of the Reformed Church since that area belongs to the Town and has become a problem for the Church
- VI. The regular meeting of the Parking Committee will be changes to the 3rd Thursday of the month at 9:45. The next meeting will be May 20, 2010.

The meeting was adjourned at 10:30 AM.
