PARKING COMMITTEE MINUTES

March 12, 1010

Trinity House--9:45 AM

Meeting was called to order at 9:45 AM by GT Schramm.

- I. There minutes of the October 2009 meeting were approved as presented
- II. David Lillard appeared regarding the property at 213 West Washington Street. The mayor told him that we had dealt with that situation on February 19, 2008 and referred it to the Zoning Officer and Planning Commission.
- III. It was reported that there was a parking issue regarding 107 South Princess Street. Upon sale it was represented that there was parking. There is none. There is no action needed by the Committee.
- IV. A letter was received by representative of the Presbyterian Church requesting that the Handicapped Signs be moved to the other side of South King Street. The Committee recommends the action.
- V. There is a need to replace some inoperative Parking Meters and to *purchase enough meters to place them on German Street from Church Street to the end of Trinity Church property*, thus eliminating the 90 minute parking enforcement issue in that spot. The committee recommends that it be determined how many meters will be needed and that the Council authorize their purchase.
- VI. It was reported that people were irate about the \$100 “boot fee”. University officials are among those who believe it to be too high. There was much discussion. In a spirit of cooperation with Shepherd University officials, *the Committee recommended to Council that the “boot fee” be lowered to \$75.*

The meeting was adjourned at 10:30 AM.
