- 1. <u>CALL TO ORDER.</u> The Water and Sanitary Boards meeting was called to order by Jim Auxer at 7:02pm at Town Hall in Shepherdstown, West Virginia.
- 2. <u>MINUTES OF THE MAY 31, 2012 REGULAR MEETING.</u> The minutes of the May 31 meeting were not available and will be reviewed at the next meeting.
- 3. <u>VISITORS.</u> No visitors were present at the meeting.
- **FINANCES.** Financial statements as of May 31 were briefly reviewed. It was noted that emergency expenses were lower than budgeted for both the water and sanitary operations.
- **FLOW AND QUALITY REPORTS.** Board members noted the positive impact on water quality readings due to bringing on new operations at the wastewater treatment plant. Spikes in flows due to rainfalls were noted. Also, a court hearing regarding the proposed EPA fine for prior water quality violations is scheduled for July 24.

6. OLD BUSINESS.

- **6.a** WASTEWATER TREATMENT PLANT UPGRADE. J. Ekstrom reported the new system is being brought on-line and all is running as planned, with the schedule to have the new operation fully in place by the end of July.
- **6.b NEW WATER TANKS.** J. Ekstrom indicated that contracts should be signed the week of July 16, and destruction of the first existing tank will start in August.
- **6.c** WATER VALVE REPLACEMENT. There was no discussion on this item.
- **6.d MADDEX FARMS PUMP STATION REPLACEMENT.** Still waiting on the power company (Potomac Edison) to come out and remove the old active line and the old meter.

7. NEW BUSINESS.

7.a <u>HIGH SERVICE PUMP REPLACEMENT AT THE WATER TREATMENT PLANT</u>. It was reported to the Boards that four contractors are applying to supply a new high service pump

- to provide better mixing at the water treatment plant. Bids are scheduled to be opened on July 12.
- **8.** MAYOR'S REPORT. Mayor Auxer reported the town is planning a dedication ceremony for the official opening of the upgraded and expanded wastewater treatment plant. A date has not yet been set.
- 9. <u>ADJOURNMENT.</u> J. Auxer adjourned the meeting at 7:18pm. The next meeting of the Boards is scheduled at Town Hall at 7:00pm on Thursday, July 26, 2012. [NOTE: The July meeting was not held due to a lack of new business, and the next meeting is now scheduled for Thursday, August 30.]
