Agenda Item 1: Mayor Jim Auxer called the August 26, 2013 Public Works Committee meeting to order at 9:45 a.m.

Agenda Item 2: Minutes – Moved by David Springer, Unanimously Approved.

Old Business:

Agenda Item 3: Nuisance Properties – House on corner of Washington St. and Church St. has been an on-going problem with weeds. Town workers will trim weeds along street on both sides of house and bill property owner.

107 + 109 Washington St. needs a letter of compliance on weeds. Also sidewalks on certain parts of Washington St. are hard to walk down because of weeds.

A set policy needs to be in place in order to decide when action is taken and how far the “Town” is willing to go before municipal court is an option.

Agenda Item 4: Sidewalks : North and South running sidewalks have been surveyed and letters have been sent to property owners for repairs. East and West running sidewalks will be surveyed in the near future.

The installation of curbing is on-going and property owners are extremely happy. The company (Gull Corporation) may be asked to come back in the future for more work.

The brick area around the Library has been relayed on a concrete base and appears to be accomplishing what it was intended to do.

Agenda Item 5: Stormwater Management : This will be discussed at the September, 2013 meeting. Matt Pennington and Hal Snyder will be invited to that meeting.

Agenda Item 6: Paving – East New St. and Church St. need to be paved. Some engineering will likely be needed in order to repair these streets.
