- 1. <u>CALL TO ORDER.</u> The Water and Sanitary Boards meeting was called to order by J. Auxer at 6:43pm at Town Hall in Shepherdstown, West Virginia.
- **MINUTES FROM LAST MEETING.** The draft minutes of the May 7, 2015 regular meeting were reviewed and approved as presented.
- 3. <u>VISITORS.</u> The two visitors did not speak at this meeting.
- **FINANCES.** P. Dowell spoke to the boards regarding new State requirements to maintain a cash working capital reserve of no less than one eighth (12.5%) of annual operation and maintenance expenses.

ACTION ITEM: J. AUXER MOVED THAT, IF THERE ARE NO OBJECTIONS, THE SANITARY BOARD ADOPTS THE PROPOSED BUDGET REVISION #1 FOR THE SHEPHERDSTOWN SEWER OPERATING FUND TO MEET STATE REQUIREMENTS TO MAINTAIN A CASH WORKING CAPITAL RESERVE, AS PRESENTED. NO OBJECTIONS WERE MADE.

- **FLOW AND QUALITY REPORTS.** High flows were noted, ascribed to a major leak and lots of rain over the month of May. Quality reports looked good.

- **6.a WATER PLANT UPGRADE.** G. Belcher participated in a conference call last week concerning financing of water plant upgrades. The market for bond financing is being explored. Also, Mayor Auxer is working with local banks on potential loans.
- **6.b SLUDGE STORAGE BUILDING.** This project is complete.
- **6.c BIOSOLIDS APPLICATION UPDATE.** Submission for approval has been made to the State, which has up to six months to approve.
- **6.d SLUDGE SPREADER TRUCK.** The new truck has been ordered.
- 6.e REPLACEMENT OF WATER LINE ROUTE 480 SOUTH (SHEPHERDSTOWN MIDDLE SCHOOL TO JANUS RESIDENCE). This project is currently on hold.
