E. Historic Landmarks Commission:

The HLC met on 10/12/15. Their recommendations are as follows:

15-40 Recommended approval
15-41 Applicant changed the application to reside the west side of her house with wood instead of Hardi Board. The commission recommended approval as amended. The commission did not feel that the Hardi Board was appropriate for residing one
side of the house. Ms. Gross explained that the west side is the coldest side of her house and that she wants, more than anything else, to protect the original logs. She explains that the Hardi Board will have the same wood grain & bead as the existing
wood siding & is less expensive than wood. M. Taylor does not believe the Hardi Board comes in the exact same width as the existing wood siding and will not ultimately match up. Mr. Taylor also states that he installed the current wood siding on the house in 1982
and that it is therefore not original wood siding which, according to the historic guidelines should be repaired rather than replaced. Eventhough not original, the commission still feels repairing and replacing with wood would be more appropriate.
