PARKING COMMITTEE MINUTES

November 19, 2015

Meeting was called to order at 9:45 AM by Mayor Auxer.

- I. The Agenda and minutes of the last meeting were approved.
- II. Susan Reichel had a couple of comments for the committee about the system. The first was that Parkmobile had not changed her license tag in their system so she got a ticket. Parkmobile's contract has expired and a new system will be in place in January. She also recommended that realtors be informed of the process for acquiring parking passes so that they could inform prospective buyers. The committee agreed. The information will be given to her to circulate to the board of Realtors.
- III. Mark Everhart addressed the committee regarding the rule that residential parking passes not be given to people in apartments constructed after 1978 since those tenants should have off street parking as required by the ordinance. He suggested that they be given a residential pass and allowed to park there anyway. The mayor will see how many people are affected. He also suggested a change to the Parking Manual reflecting this rule more clearly. That will be done.
- IV. Peter Corum requested an additional Employee Pass from the committee due to having hired a new full time employee. The committee approved his request for one more employee pass.
- V. The Passport Program is moving ahead and will be completed by the first week in January.

The meeting was adjourned at 10:00 AM.
