## **DRAFT MINUTES**

## SHEPHERDSTOWN, WEST VIRGINIA WATER & SANITARY BOARDS July 28, 2016

1. <u>CALL TO ORDER.</u> The Water and Sanitary Boards meeting was called to order by J. Auxer at 6:30pm at Town Hall in Shepherdstown, West Virginia.

Special note: It was announced that William Myers retired from the Water Plant staff after 40+ years of dedicated and excellent service.

- **MINUTES FROM LAST MEETINGS.** The draft minutes of the June regular meeting were approved as presented.
- 3. <u>VISITORS.</u> None
- **FINANCES.** In reviewing the June 30 fiscal year-end financials, the Boards thanked the Town staff for doing a tremendous job in monitoring the budget and keeping expenses down.
- 5. <u>FLOW AND QUALITY REPORTS.</u> Phosphorus levels in the effluent will continue to be an issue, but various adjustments with the chemical applications are being tried and the results closely monitored until a solution is found.
- 6. UNFINISHED BUSINESS.
- **6.a WATER PLANT UPGRADE.** Some problems with algae have been noted, applying new covers over settling basins, with success to date.
- **6.b BIOSOLIDS APPLICATION.** Currently on track to reduce expenses by at least \$35,000/year; F. Welch said this is turning out to be a very good program.
- **CRESS CREEK PUMP STATION.** Bids have been received and the pump has been ordered. A pre-bid meeting is scheduled for August 4, and bid openings for August 16, 2016.
- **6.d SOURCE WATER PROTECTION.** Shepherdstown's plan was submitted on July 1.
- **6.e GRAVITY SEWER LINE.** No new developments.
- **6.f DIRECT WATER LINE TO WATER TANKS (CROSS-CONNECTION PROGRAM).** No new developments.
- **6.g SHEPHERDSTOWN EAST DEVELOPMENT.** Currently reviewing submitted plans. There are options for the placement of sewer lines.

## 7. <u>NEW BUSINESS.</u>

- 7.a WATER METER TESTING AND REPLACEMENT. Testing will begin the first week in August. Will be testing 2, 3, and 4 inch meters. To date, 170 meters have already been replaced.
- **8.** <u>MAYOR'S REPORT.</u> Mayor Auxer complimented Town staff on the great job they are doing at both the Drinking Water Plant and the Waste Water Treatment Plant.
- **9. ADJOURNMENT.** J. Auxer adjourned the meeting at 7:51pm. The next regular meeting is scheduled for Thursday, August 25 [later changed to Thursday, September 1] at 6:30pm at Town Hall.
