It was agreed to increase Unallocated Video Lottery to \$150,000, include \$45,000 for Police Vehicles, reduce R/E Tax by \$14,000 and note that the Parks and Recreation Committee Budget should be at \$27,000. It was moved with no objection by C. Roberts to recommend approval by Town Council. Unanimous.
- e. Funding for recycling cans Lori Robertson reported that funding is needed to replace the cans on the street with units that will include trash/recycling/glass cans. The current grant will cover approximately 1/3 of the cost. She is requesting \$15,000. Moved with no objection by J. Ford, to recommend approval of \$15,000 from Unallocated Video Lottery for the purchase of new recycling cans. Unanimous.
- f. Shepherd University Alternative Spring Break Fundraising Kahlen Browning was present on behalf of Shepherd University to explain this project and its successes.
