# D. Committee scope of work:

It has been frustrating not receiving any responses back from other committees or individuals regarding various projects. If this continues to occur, deadlines will be missed and projects cannot move forward.

As an example, the Committee has decided not to move forward with the T-Mobile grant regarding the development of a common space in Town as this project does not have a project manager at this time.

1. Tree inventory – DWG questioned who is to vet the proposals received for the tree inventory. She stated that Frank Welch, or the Tree Commission, as project leader(s) should do this.

It was discussed that all three (3) proposals meet the criteria for this Committee. CPS to reach out to both Frank and the Tree Commission and request that they select the vendor.

Upon such selection, the matter should be recommended to Town Council for final determination, with possible referral to Finance to approve the match.
