NOTICE OF DECISION

Re: Complaint regarding deer harborage at 205 E. German Street

Dear Mr. Puglisi and Mr. Kendall:

Please be advised that the Shepherdstown Public Works Committee meeting in regular session on Monday, September 25, 2023, concluded:

- 1. The wooded area to the rear of 205 E. German Street is not in violation of any section of the International Property Maintenance Code as adopted by the Corporation of Shepherdstown.
- 2. The "continuing deer problem" you have cited be referred to the Shepherdstown Deer Task Force for resolution.

The Commission based its decision upon the following:

Finding of Facts and Conclusions of Law:

- 1. The wooded area containing approximately 0.21 acres to the rear of parcel ID # 19-10-0003-0022-0000 has remained as such since the creation of the lot.
- The wooded area does not constitute "rubbish and garbage" as referenced in section 302.1 (Exterior Property Areas) of the International Property Maintenance Code.

3. Section 302.4 of the International Property Maintenance Code defines "Noxious Weeds" as "all grasses, annual plants and vegetation, other than trees or shrubs provided; however, this term shall not include cultivated flowers and gardens".

 Section 302.5 (Rodent Harborage) requires "structures and exterior property shall be kept free from rodent harborage and infestation. The definition of rodent does not include deer.
