Agenda Item 1: Mayor Jim Auxer called the January 27, 2013 Public Works Committee meeting to order at 9:50 a.m.

Agenda Item 2: Minutes – Moved by Bane Schill, Unanimously Approved.

New Business:

Agenda Item 3: Ken Clohan (DOH) – The following questions were asked –

- (a) Can Curbing be installed throughout Town on State maintained roads? Yes, curbing can be installed as long as it is 18” in depth and is placed in low speed areas.
- (b) What can be done at the 4-way stop about the asphalt that is so unlevel? Mr. Clohan will look at the problem.
- (c) Can the bridge lights that are out be replaced? Yes
- (d) What is the status on the jersey walls that are on N. Duke Street coming into town? They are permanent fixtures.
- (e) What is the status on the 4-Way Stop on Duke St. and High St? This will be left in place for now.
- (f) Can striping be re-done on the State maintained roads? Yes
- (g) Will Washington St. / Princess St. get a crosswalk? No

Old Business:

Agenda Item 4: E. New St. milling and paving: This is in the hands of Chapman Technical for their recommendations.

Agenda Item 5: Recycling – Figures for 2013 were given out by Frank Welch. Recycling tonnage has risen over the years.

Agenda Item 6: Bulky Items: Lori Robertson inquired about bulky items such as couches and chairs. What is the procedure for picking them up? Usually those people who put those items out pay a special pick-up fee for their removal. What is happening now is that students or people that abandon apartments are setting out the items and leaving Town. Some of these items in certain areas will need to be disposed of by the town workers and landlords will be notified.

Agenda Item 7: During the recent snowstorms, some sidewalks were not cleaned according to the town’s ordinances. The Police Dept. will start putting hangers on violator’s doors.
