Agenda Item 1: Mayor Jim Auxer called the June 27, 2016 Public Works Committee meeting to order at 9:50 a.m.

New Business:

Agenda Item 3: Bamboo in Town – Rebecca Ayraude gave a presentation on Bamboo. The plant is very invasive. Once it starts, it is very hard to get rid of and spreads very fast. There are two types of bamboo: Golden and Yellow Grove. Some states have prohibition policies against bamboo and strictly enforce the planting of it. In order to get rid of it, the roots would have to be completely dug out and a possible herbicide used in that area. If a neighbor planted on a property line, it could spread onto the other neighbor's property very quickly.

The Committee decided to contact their lawyer for legal advice and possibly pass an ordinance on Bamboo.

Agenda Item 4: Slowing Traffic at Train Station – Complaints have been made by the Train Station Board and neighbors in the area of the Train Station about the speeding through Audrey Egle Blvd. It was decided by the committee to place a speed bump or speed hump on the Blvd. Dr. Davis will be contacted to get his views on this.
