1. Call to order – 10:08 a.m.
2. Approval of Minutes of October meeting – Motion by C. Roberts to approve minutes as written. Approved with no objections.

5. New Business
  - a) Police ballistic vest outer carriers. Chief King explained the need for all officers to have vests. Plan is in place to purchase 5 outer carriers. Panels for vests will be purchased later in the year when there is an opportunity to buy them at half price from the government.
  - b) Narcan. Chief King explained that it has been generally decided that EMS units should be responsible for carrying and administering Narcan. However, national consensus is that each police office should keep 2 doses on hand to handle any accidental overdoses of personnel.
  - c) Dog Training. Chief King stated that our new dog, Apollo, is working very well. Apollo can also be safely used for tracking since he is not aggressive – no attack training.
  - d) E-Ticket. Chief King explained that we have acquired 3 printers from the State of WV at no charge. All cars are now equipped to issue E-Tickets.
  - e) Ballistic Shield. Chief King explained the need for a ballistic shield to be used in case of an active shooter incident. Cost is \$1500 which we do have available in the Coal Severance fund. Motion by C. Roberts to authorize purchase of 1 ballistic shield for approximately \$1500 to be paid for from Coal Severance fund. Approved with no objections.
