

Bane- Harris Park - Maiden Lane & W. High Street - Shepherdstown

The first community park inside the corporation of Shepherdstown, established/ dedicated on April 2, 1982 by the Shepherdstown Housing Authority with a HUD Block Grant. The park was named in honor of John W. Harris and Quinton Bane, community activists and supporters of programs to promote community involvement and the enjoyment of our historic town. John W. Harris was the Principal of Shady Side School (W. High Street) and East Side School (current site of Shepherdstown Day Care – E. German Street). Quinton Bane was Reverend of St. John's Parsonage (W. German Street). Both men displayed outstanding support in the community and for the development and construction of the park. Mr. Harris was a scholar and a landowner. Reverend Bane offered the St. John's Parsonage to Shepherdstown's Housing Authority for their meetings.
